

ATHLETIC REMINDERS & UPDATES FOR 2025-2026 FOR CRIVITZ MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- **REQUIRED ANNUAL CODE MEETING** – THERE WILL BE AN IN-PERSON CODE MEETING FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR. Mark your calendars for Monday August 4th 2025 at 7:00 p.m. in the high school gym. This year the meeting will not be filmed so please make arrangements to attend on August 4th at 7:00 p.m. There will be important information shared regarding some of the new WIAA guidelines that were passed by the membership this past spring regarding Name, Image, and Likeness. In addition, Emplify Health by Bellin will be here for providing some education regarding ACL injuries. At least ONE parent/guardian must attend along with each student that wishes to participate in extracurricular activities in the Crivitz School District for the 2025-2026 academic year.
- **ACTIVITY/ATHLETIC PAPERWORK** – This process will be done through ONLINE registration. Please note that Aribiter Sports has acquired RSchool as of July 1st, 2025. Your usernames and passwords from the past will carry over to the new platform, but the registration process will be slightly different than in years past. The direct link for the online registration site is <https://students.arbitersports.com/organizations/crivitz-school-district>. This will be made available on Monday July 21st, 2025. Please do not try to register before July 21st, 2025 for the 2025-2026 academic year.

Q: What do I need to do in advance, so that I am ready to go on that first day of practice?

You will need an alternate year card or a physical completed before the first day of practice. The alternate year form or physical form MAY BE turned in online or turned into the office. The below forms will be accessible online (including the physical and alternate year card form under your arbiter registration) under your family account.


- i) **WIAA Athletic Permit Form (Physical Form)** – This card certifies that the student has had a physical and is physically able to compete. This form is kept on file and is valid for two (2) school years for all Crivitz High School/Middle School athletic teams. You may download the completed form on the athletic registration website or bring the hard copy into the office. *Schedule an appointment with your doctor early in the summer! Not having a physical or having to wait for an appointment to open is normally the biggest problem for athletes not being able to start practice on time at the beginning of the season.*
- ii) **CHS/CMS Activities Code Handbook (Parent and Student Activities Code Contract)** – This contract obligates the student and the parent to comply with the rules as set forth in this Activities Code and the team standards as determined by the team coach. This contract is kept on file and is valid for one (1) year for all Crivitz High School/Middle School activities. (Complete at In-Person Meeting on August 4th, 2025.
- iii) **WIAA Athlete Eligibility Information Bulletin (AEIB)** – this bulletin clarifies rules regarding age, academics, attendance, residence, transfers, physicals, training rules, amateur status, and activities outside of school. (Online Registration)
- iv) **Medical Information Disclosure (Release) Form** – This form is required for the release of medical information to appropriate parties for the proper training, care and treatment of our student-athletes in addition to baseline concussion testing. (Online Registration)
- v) **Medical Information Form** – This information is required before students may participate in any school activity. **PLEASE FILL OUT ALL FORMS TO THEIR ENTIRITY.** Physician's names/address/contact number, etc. are all required. (Online Registration)
- vi) **Transportation Liability Form**—Even if the student is riding the bus to and from away events, this form must be signed. **PLEASE INCLUDE SPECIFIC NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS WHO COULD POTENTIALLY BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF YOUR CHILD THROUGHOUT THE SEASON.** (Online Registration)
- vii) **Participation Fee**—(\$250 participation fee per family that is eligible to be reimbursed upon the completion of working four time slots in the concession stand during events sponsored by the Wolverine Sports Boosters for the 2025-2026 school year)

Q: Can I begin practice without having the required paperwork turned into the school office?

No! The WLAA requires a completed WLAA Athletic Permit Card (Physical Card) and online registration to be on file in our office for each athlete participating on an athletic team. In addition, our Board of Education requires that the signed code contract be on file as well as all the medical forms/fees in order to participate. **ALL PAPERWORK IS REQUIRED TO BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN ANY PRACTICE.** If you are having issues with your online account, you may click on forgot password and a new password will be emailed to you.
